

**Friends of the
South Whitley Community Public Library
By-Laws**

Article I. Name: The name of the organization shall be Friends of the South Whitley Community Public Library. The address shall be that of the South Whitley Community Public Library, namely, 201 East Front Street, South Whitley, IN 46787.

Article II. Purpose: To promote the functions, resources, services, and needs of the South Whitley Community Public Library. To encourage contributions and memorials.

Article III. Membership: Membership shall be open to any individual interested in supporting the South Whitley Community Public Library. Each member is entitled to vote, to participate in work, and to hold office.

Article IV. Officers: Officers shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary. All officers will serve 2-year terms.

Article V. Committees: The President shall appoint necessary committees; their duties being implied by their respective titles.

Article VI. Meetings: The organization shall meet monthly or as agreed upon by a majority of the members, at a date and time agreed upon by a majority of the members.

Article VII. Amendments: Amendments to the By-Laws can be made after a motion has been presented to the entire membership and voted on by a majority at a subsequent meeting.

Article VIII. Parliamentary Procedure: The latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order shall govern all procedure.
