**Libby - The one-tap reading app  
from your local library.**

**Step 1**

Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android, iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), or Windows 10 device.

**Step 2**

In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.

**Step 3**

Browse the library's collection and borrow a title.

**Step 4**

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi so you can read them when you're offline.

From your Shelf, you can:

- Tap Open Book, Open Audiobook, or Open Magazine to start reading or listening.
- Tap Manage Loan to see options like Renew, Return, or Send to Device to send a book to Kindle.

You are allowed up to 10 checkouts at one time.

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**Overdrive for computers**

**Step 1**

Visit [www.swcplib.com](http://www.swcplib.com), click Digital Resources then choose the Overdrive link.

**Step 2**

Sign in to your Overdrive account with your library card.

**Step 3**

Browse for a title. Click borrow or place hold on the one you chose.

After you borrow a title, you can:

- Send items in Kindle format to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app.
- Read, watch, or listen to a title in your browser.
- Download an eBook, and read it using free Adobe Digital Editions software or transfer it to a supported eReader.
- Download an Audiobook and then listen to it using Overdrive's free desktop app for Windows or Mac or transfer it to a supported MP3 player.

You are allowed up to 10 checkouts at one time.

Register using your library card:

Step 1

Visit [www.swcplib.com](http://www.swcplib.com) and click Digital Resources and then the Hoopla link.

Step 2

Create your account using your email address and a password. Choose SWCPL and type in your library card number.

Step 3

Browse to choose music, eBooks, audiobooks, movies, or television.

Step 4

You are allowed to borrow 5 titles per month.

To borrow a title, click on the Titles icon and then click the Borrow button.

Explore TeachingBooks to see what they have to offer your child.



Stream films for free to your computer, phone, or tablet. You have 5 credits to use each month.

**Create a Kanopy account**

To create an account:

1. Go to [www.swcplib.com](http://www.swcplib.com) and click Digital Resources and then the Kanopy link. Select *Add library card*, if this is your first time logging in. Then you will be asked to enter your first and last name, email address, and a password of your choice. Click *Sign up*.
2. Check for an email from Kanopy and click the link to confirm your account. This will return you to Kanopy's website.
3. Enter your library card number and click *Save*.

By signing up for an account, you are confirming you are 18 years of age or older.

**Watch movies on a computer**

1. Access [Kanopy](#) from a computer by entering the email address and password you used to create your account.
2. Select *Go* to get started.
3. Browse by category or subject or search for movies you want to watch.

**Watch movies on a phone or tablet using the Kanopy app**

1. Once the app is downloaded, click on *Log in*.
2. Enter the email address and password you used to create your account.
3. Select *Go* then *Continue*.
4. Browse by category or subject or search for movies you want to watch.

A wireless connection is required to stream movies.



You can access your library card via the evergreen app or in your web browser.

- *Download* the app via your device's app store.
- After you have downloaded the app, it will ask for your user name (library card number) and password (your 6 digit birthdate - mmddyy). You will then be able to place holds, renew materials, pay fines and use it to check out items when at the library.
- To log in to your online account visit [www.swcplib.com](http://www.swcplib.com), and click on the Evergreen Indiana button.
- Select *My Account*. Enter your library card number and 6-digit birthdate password (mmddyy).
- To renew items:
  1. Click on items currently checked out.
  2. Put a check mark in the box next to the item you want to renew.
  3. Click the Go button to renew selected titles.
- To place a hold:
  1. Search the catalog for the item you wish to place on hold.
  2. Click Place Hold to the right of the title.
- To pay fines:
  1. Click the Fines tab and follow the instructions.
