July 12, 1 p.m.

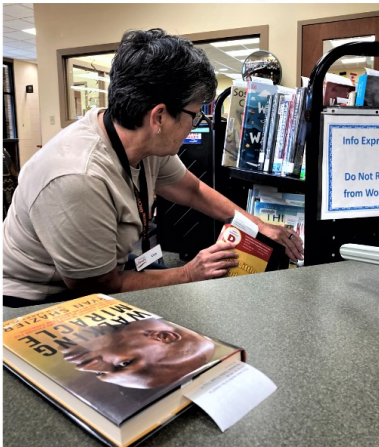
