June 15, 7 p.m.

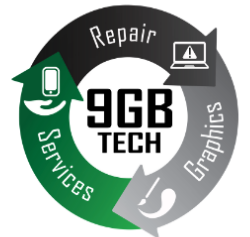



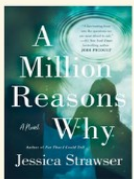
