Aug. 28, 5:45 p.m.

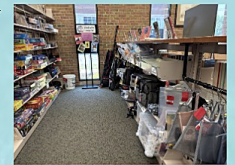
Can you keep a secret ... even if it tells the truth to the art world about a possible work of Michelangelo's?
