Take & Make Kit mid-November

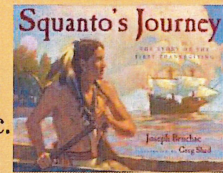

Creative Brushstrokes

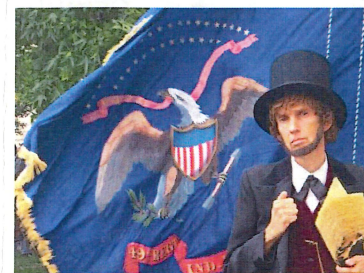
Nov. 8, 10 a.m.

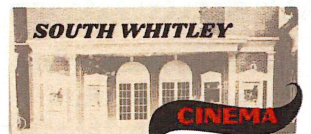
Navigating Medicare
