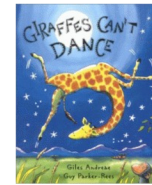

This month's spice of the month is lavender, which will be used to make lavender scones. The Spice of the Month will be available beginning April 1.



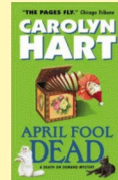
### Take & Make Kit mid-April
